February General Meeting:

Some people dig up history by looking at old photographs, combing through original documents or interviewing people who have lived through particular events. Others find out about the past by "digging in the dirt" - technically - "the study of human activity through the recovery and analysis of material culture". **Our guest in February will be Mark Campbell** from the AV Archaeological Society. Come learn how archaeologists help us learn about our past.

On October 19, 2016 a few members of the KAHS made a visit to the Tropico Gold Mine and Mill to document an important part of the history of Rosamond. We went through the assay office, the main drift, the mill, the company store, and visited the Glory Hole where the Tropico Time Tunnel is located.






